Rules and Responsibilities

Code of Conduct

1. Female contestants between the ages of 6 – 12 years are eligible for PITU Princess
Female contestants between the ages of 13 – 21 years are eligible for PITU Queen.
2. Must be an enrolled member or a descendant of PITU, all contestants must show proof if questioned.
3. Contestants must be single throughout the reign.
4. Contestants must have no children throughout their reign.
5. All contestants must show Pride, Dignity, and have a good reputation while holding any and all titles of PITU Royalty. Each contestant must maintain high moral conduct and good standards.
6. All PITU Royalty will be required to participate in the Restoration Gathering Powwow and Parade. Participation in other local functions throughout the reign is required.
7. PITU Royalty will have to report to Tribal Council on a quarterly basis during reign.
8. Pageant Committee and PITU will not be responsible for damage or loss of PITU Royalty's personal items such as jewelry, clothing and other personal belongings.
9. PITU Royalty must return crown and sash in good condition or shall be required to replace them.
10. All contestants attending school must satisfactorily complete the school year or be required to forfeit the title received.
11. If any of the PITU Royalty must forfeit the title they receive, the next in line will take the place that precedes them.
