

Temporary Food Vendor Food Safety Training

WHEN:	Friday, June 9, 2017 10:00AM – 12:30PM
WHERE:	Paiute Tribe of Utah Housing Building 565N 100E, Cedar City, UT 84721
WHO:	Anyone who operates, cooks, prepares, or serves food at food stands, powwows, or other temporary food events. This training focuses specifically on how to prepare and serve food safely in these types of operations.

The course is FREE and will cover the essential food handling information and practices necessary to prevent foodborne illnesses. Temporary Food Handler's Certification Cards will be issued following successful completion of the training. The course will be presented by LTJG Adam Mannarino, Environmental Health Officer, Indian Health Service.

***NOTE: Participants must attend the entire training to be eligible to sit for the exam.**
