Rules and Responsibilities

General Requirements:

- 6–21 years of age (Princess 6–12 years, Queen 13–21 years)
- Currently enrolled in school
- Enrolled member of Paiute Indian Tribe of Utah or descendent. All contestants must show proof if questioned.
- Never married or have dependents
- Not currently holding any other crown or title
- All Contestants are required to attend and participate in all 39th Annual Restoration Gathering and Pow-Wow functions, including the parade and all grand entries.
- PITU or Pageant Committee will not be responsible for damage or loss of contestant's personal items; such as jewelry, clothing and other personal belongings.

Responsibilities:

- Perform duties and obligations while upholding the highest standards of leadership and community involvement, as well as serving as a positive role model.
- Attend and represent at Tribal functions and various pow-wows during her reign.
- Be responsible for the care, maintenance, and safekeeping of the Paiute Indian Tribe of Utah crown and sash throughout her reign.
- Will be responsible for damaged, loss, or stolen crown.
- Will be enrolled in school
- Will not become married or pregnant
- Will not have legal problems or will immediately forfeit the crown
- Must be alcohol and drug free during reign
- If she cannot continue to uphold her responsibilities during her reign, the PITU Royalty must forfeit the title and the runner-up candidate will assume her responsibilities.
