

### **Allowable Expenses for Reimbursement due to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency:**

- Food/Groceries:
  - This will be average increased cost of food/groceries per person due to the pandemic.
  - (receipt is not required unless claiming a loss of income)
- Utilities
  - This will be average increased cost of food/groceries per person due to the pandemic.
  - (receipt is not required unless claiming a loss of income)
- Education:
  - Educational tools and supplies for children for home schooling
  - Electronics for home schooling
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)/Sanitation:
  - Masks, gloves, sanitizers
  - Cleaning supplies
  - Protective supplies/equipment
- Medical/Telehealth:
  - Non-reimbursed medicine
  - Non-reimbursed medical expenses
- Childcare:
  - Direct childcare payments
- Funeral:
  - Expenses related to COVID-19.
- Other:
  - Electronics/tools for telecommuting (including stationery, computers, printers, etc.)
  - Other supplies purchased to prepare for or respond to COVID-19
  - Expenses for food delivery (with receipt)
  - Supporting family members who are/have been impacted by COVID-19
  - Transportation costs as a result of COVID-19

### **Allowable Expenses for Reimbursement if you have experienced a loss in income:**

- Mortgage/Rent (100%) – *must submit documentation*
- Utilities (100%) – *must submit documentation*
- Insurance – *must submit documentation*
- Other necessary household expenses required to maintain critical services during the pandemic.

### **Ineligible Expenses include but are not limited to:**

- Any expenses not tied directly to COVID-19.
- COVID-19 response expenses incurred prior to March 1, 2020.
- Any expenses covered or reimbursable by another funding source.
- Lost revenue due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Rent/Mortgage (unless you experienced a loss in income).
- Loan payments.
- Vehicle repair/upgrades.
- Any regular occurring bills which were not impacted by COVID-19.
